### ◀ BIKE HITCH

The 'Follow Me' coupling – which attaches a child's bike behind an adult cycle – looks to me like one of the safer and better of this genre, which has seen the creation of some truly awful contraptions. The worst of them rely on the child's bike's headset for the steering: unfortunately the angles are all wrong. This device is much more sensible and puts a vertical pivot just behind the lead bike's rear wheel. The attachment is nice and light, like the best trailers, giving the adult rider plenty of leverage to override any imbalances from the child. It also attaches solidly to both bikes, leaves pannier space free on the front machine, and tucks away quite neatly when detached. It's suitable for children from around 4 to 9 years old and for bikes with 12 to 20 inch wheels. The kit costs €235. The inventor and manufacturer is Thomas Weiss, from Laufenburg, Switzerland.
